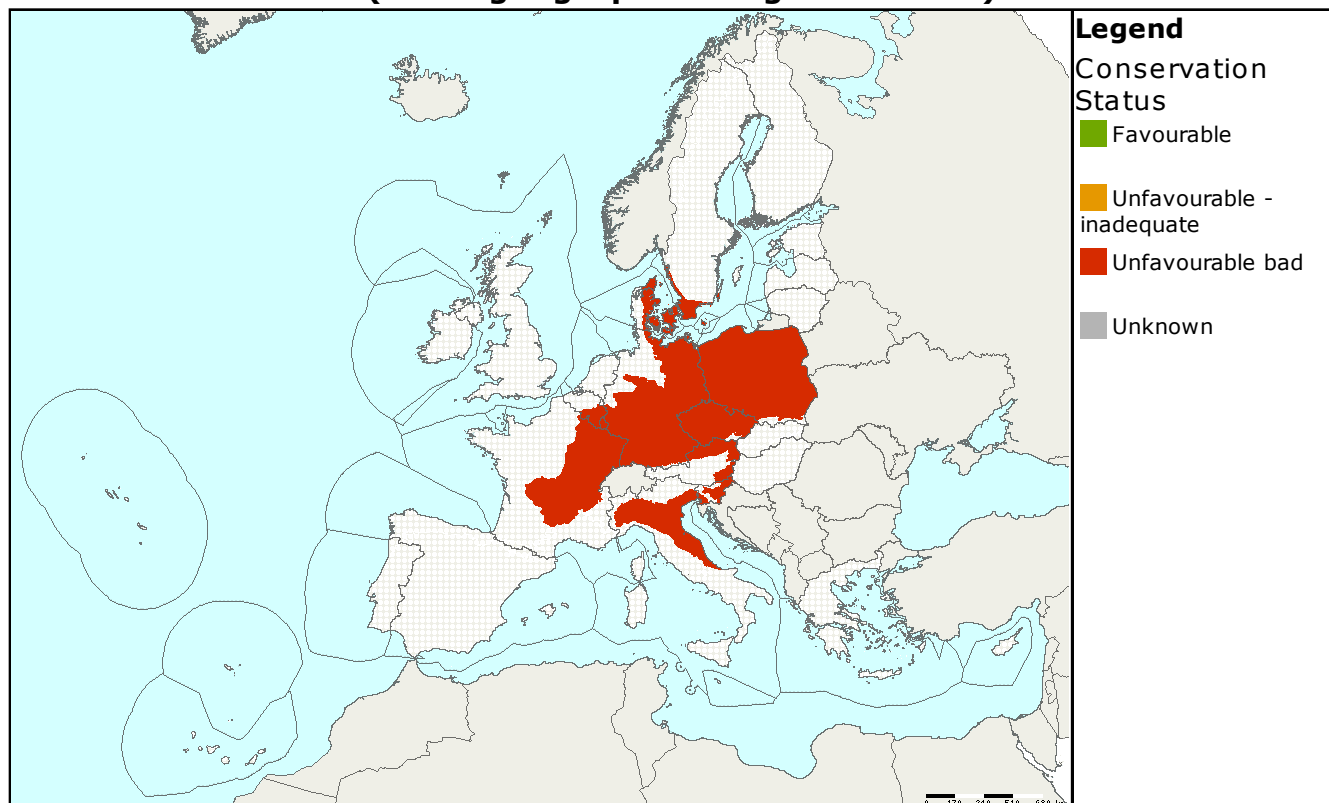

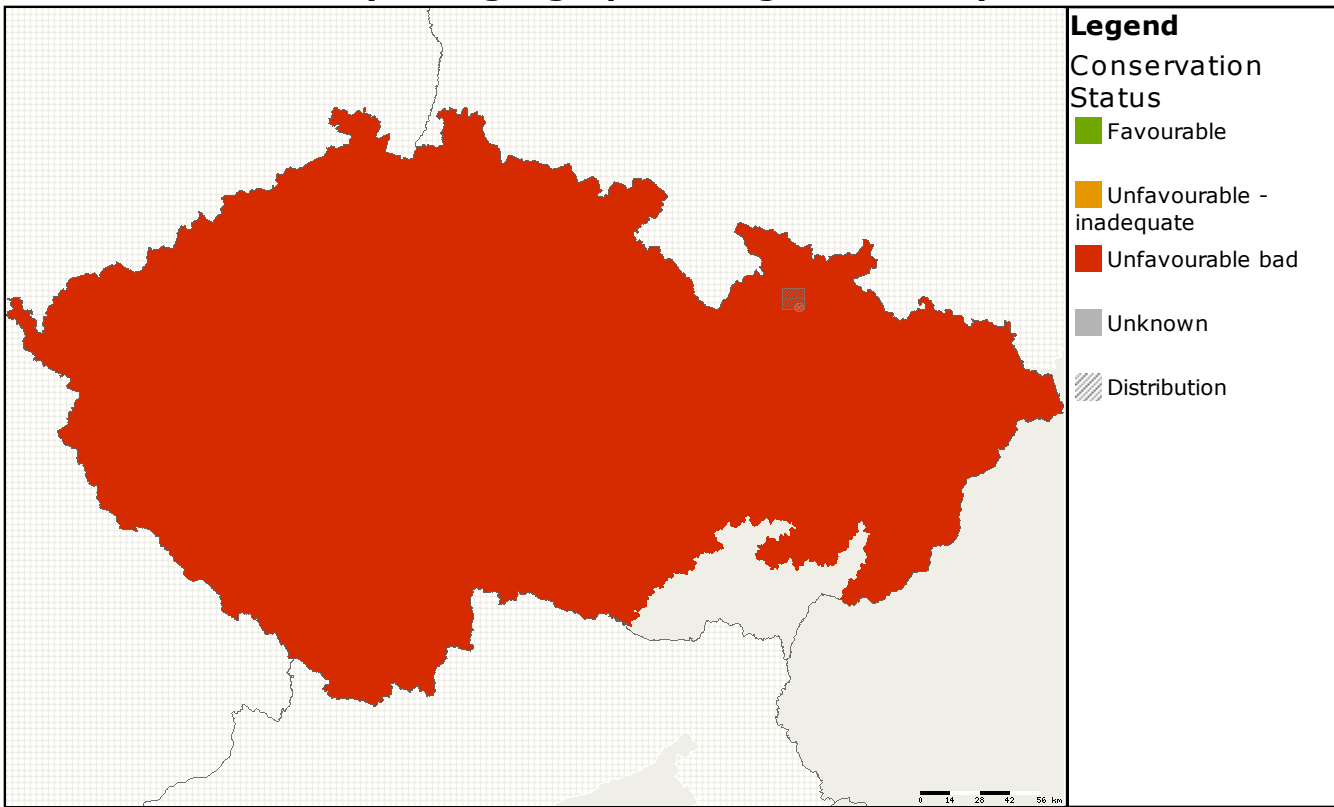

CON: Reported only from a restricted area in north-eastern CZ: the Jeseniky Mts. "Bad" future prospects lead the final conclusion to "bad", in spite of "favourable" range and habitat. Threatened by mountaineering, rock climbing, speleology surveys, trampling, eutrophication and other natural processes.
