

Salix salvifolia ssp. australis is an endemic plant to Portugal according to Portuguese authorities, but it is also reported by Spain with presence in Andalucia. The overall status of conservation for the species is "unfavourable-inadequate" with poor information reported by both countries. Better information is required for the species.
