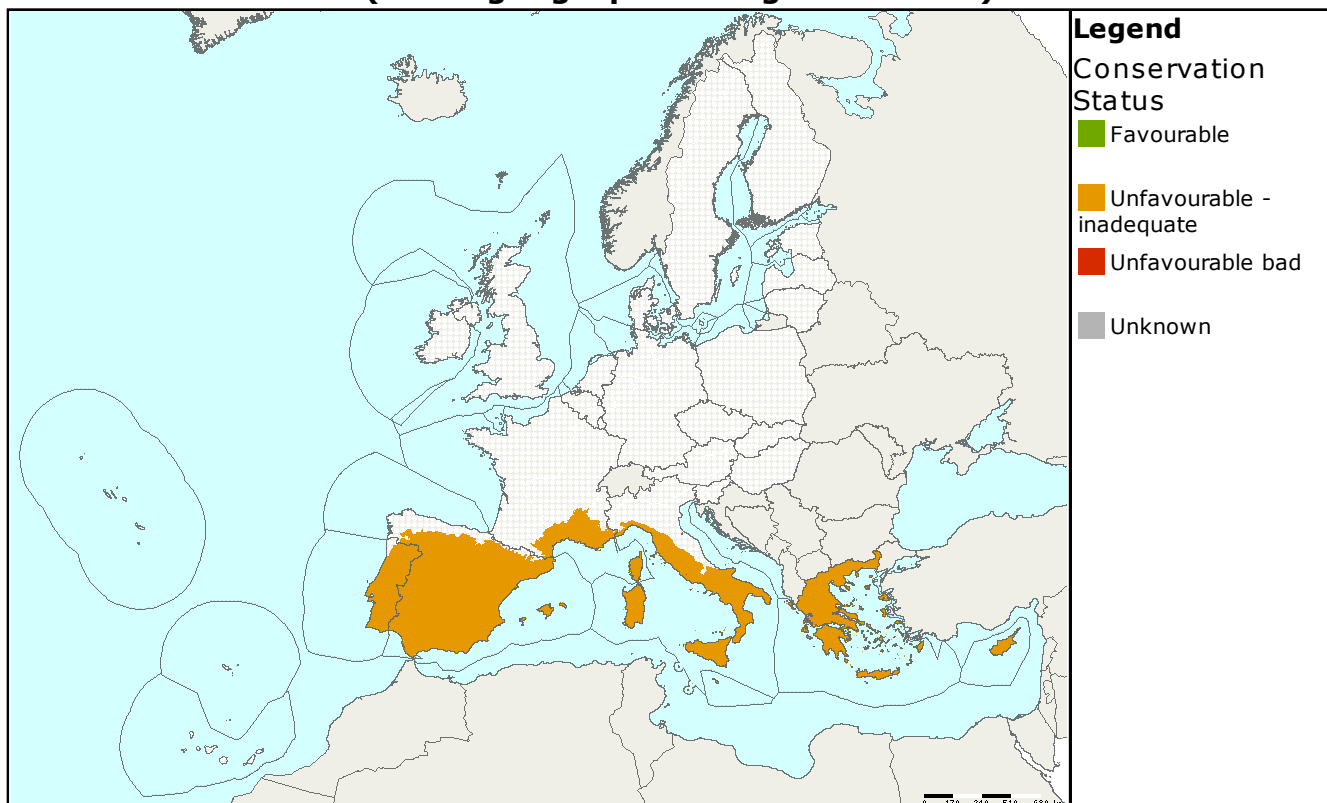

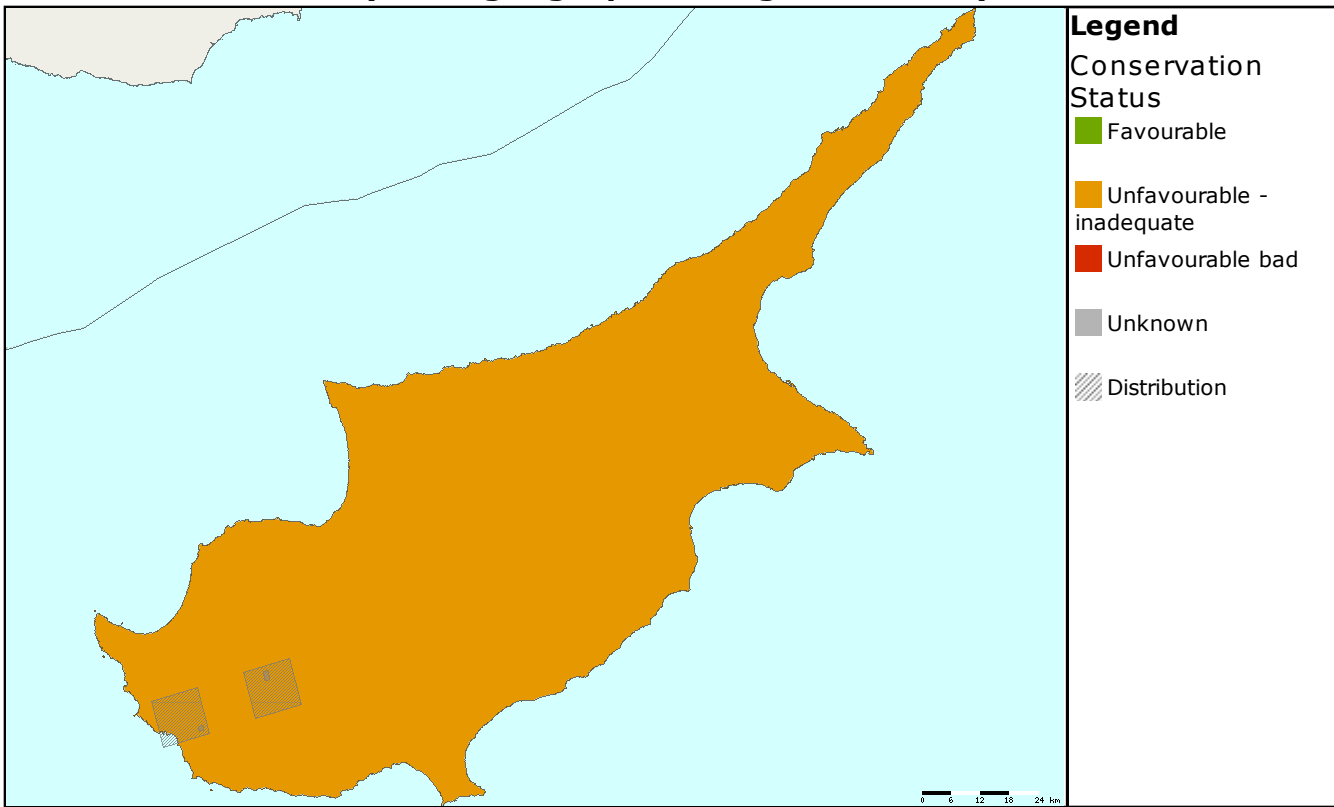

MED: There are 2 extant subpopulations of the species in 5 locations. It was first discovered in 1974 at only one location. Part of the population at two locations has been irretrievably lost (in 2004, 2006, 2007) due to road construction and expansion of cultivations. U1 conclusion prevails, population and habitat trends are decreasing.
