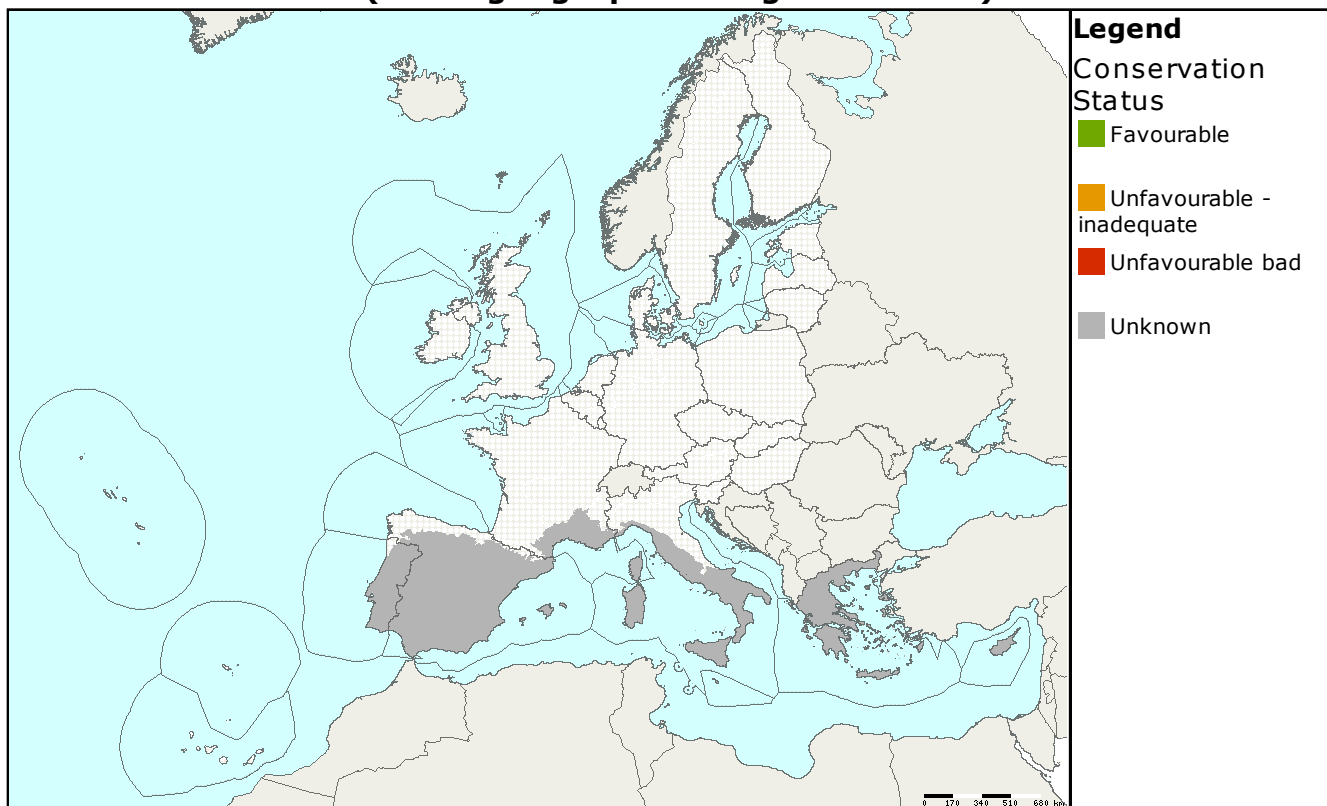

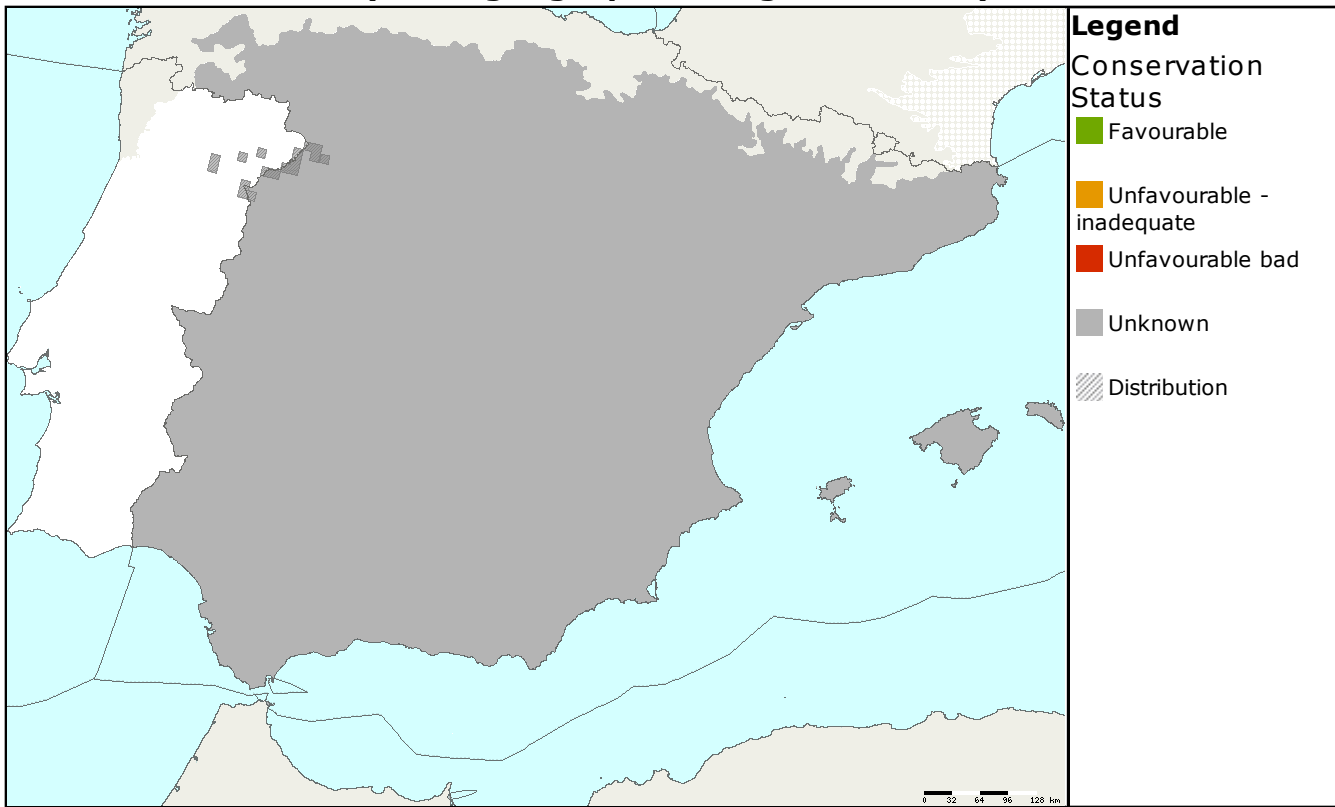
## Assessments of conservation status at the European level (all biogeographical regions - EU25)

*Holcus setigulumis ssp. Duriensis* is a grass species reported from Mediterranean biogeographical region by Spain and Portugal. It is endemic species restricted to north-western part of the Iberian Peninsula. The overall assessment is 'unknown' due to such assessment of all parameters by Spain and no other possible assessment for almost all parameters in Portugal. However, the future prospects were assessed as 'favourable' by Portugal.
