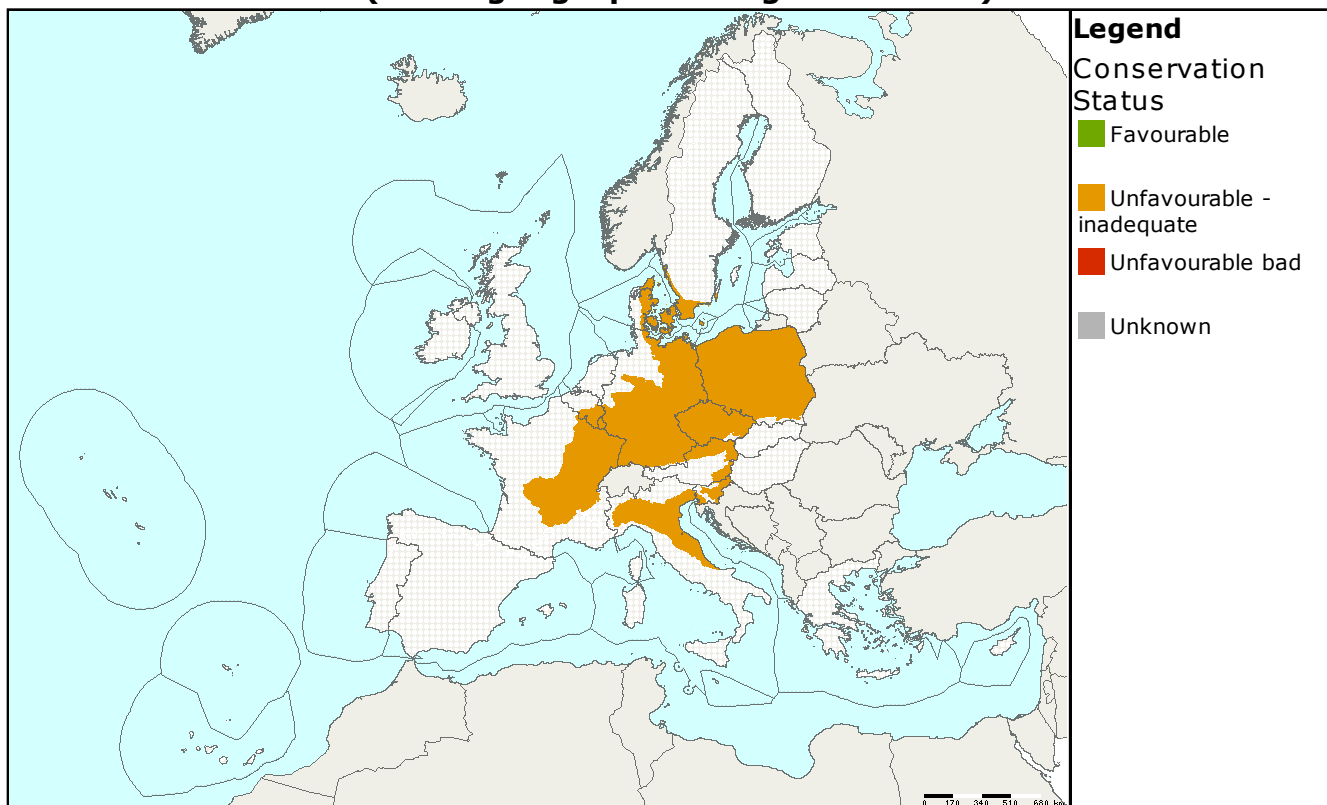

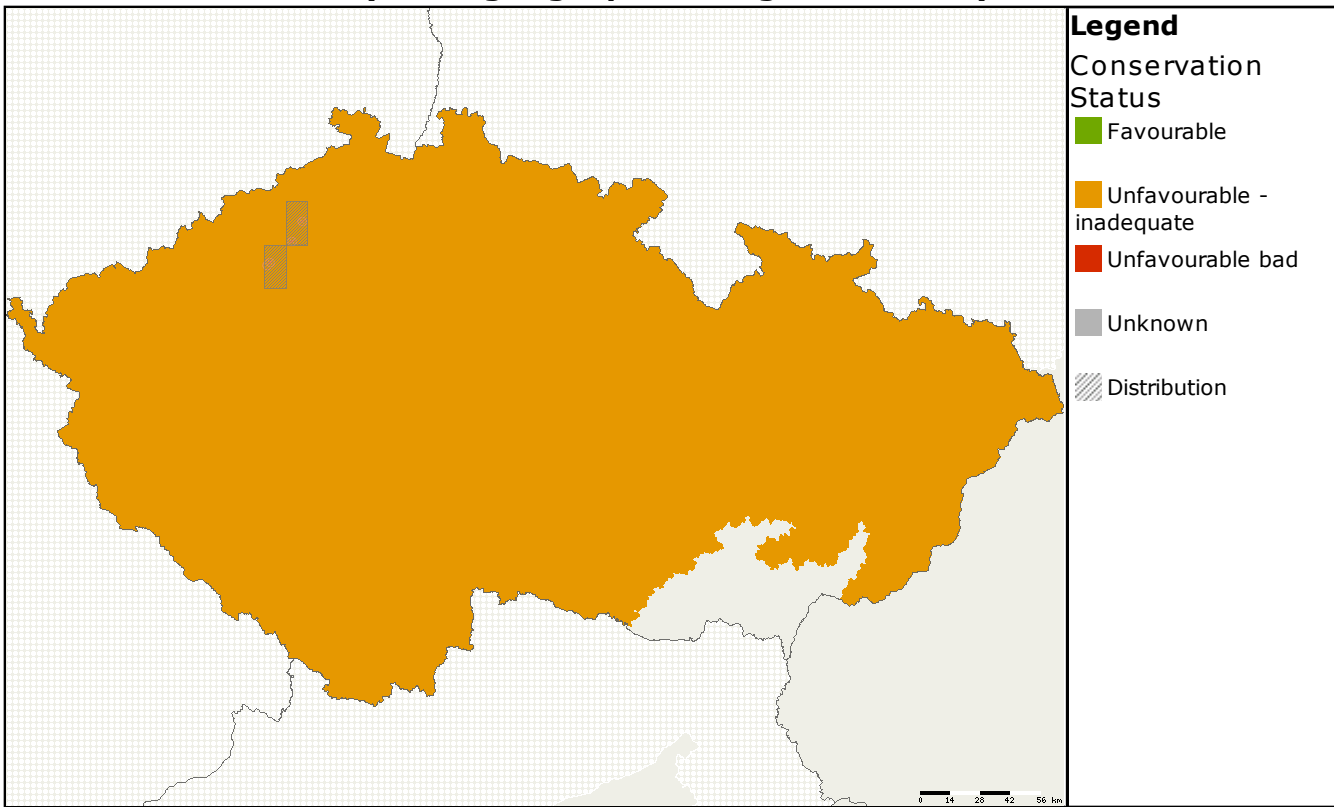

CON: Known also as *Stipa rubens* or *Stipa glabrata*. Reported only from NW Czech Republic (close to Lovosice and Libochovany). On one locality, there is a danger of extinction of the species. "Inadequate" population and future prospects determine the overall conclusion although the range and habitat are in "favourable" status.
