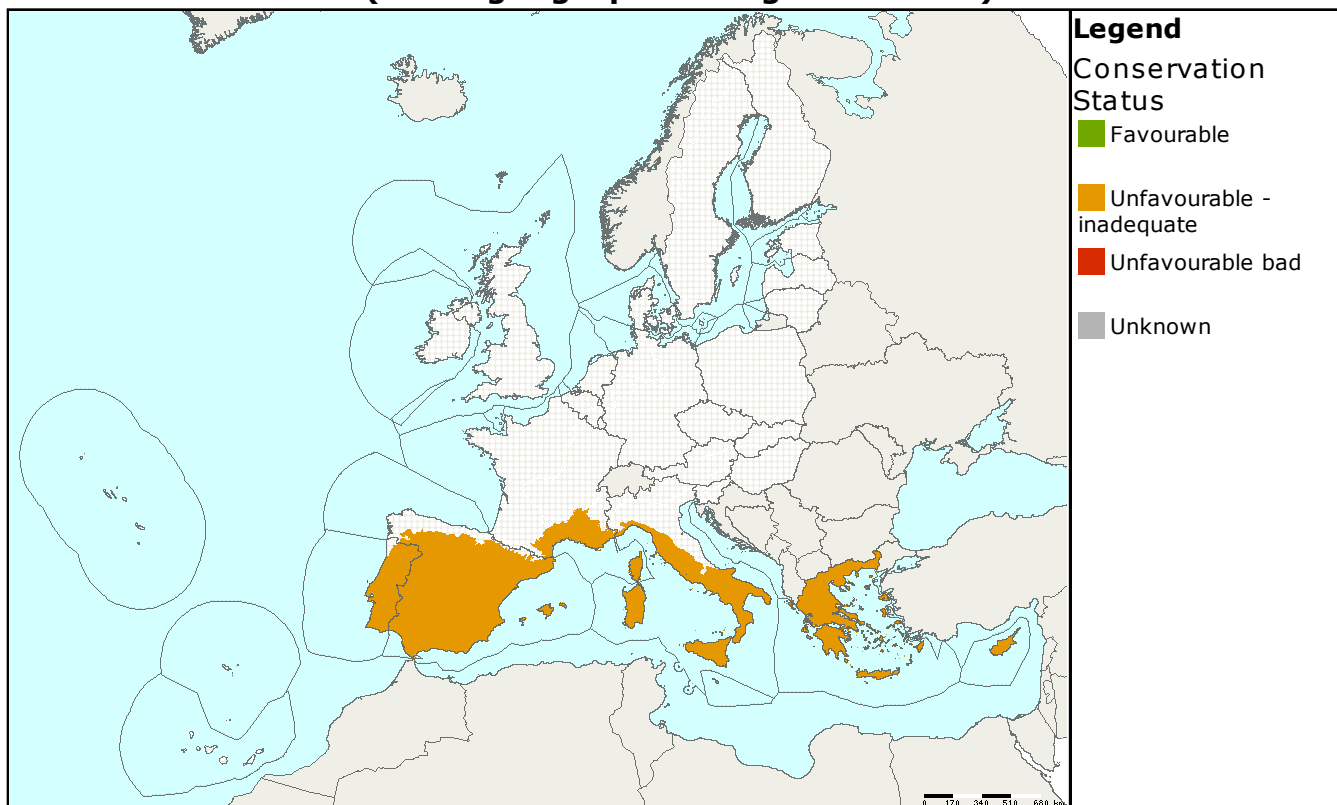

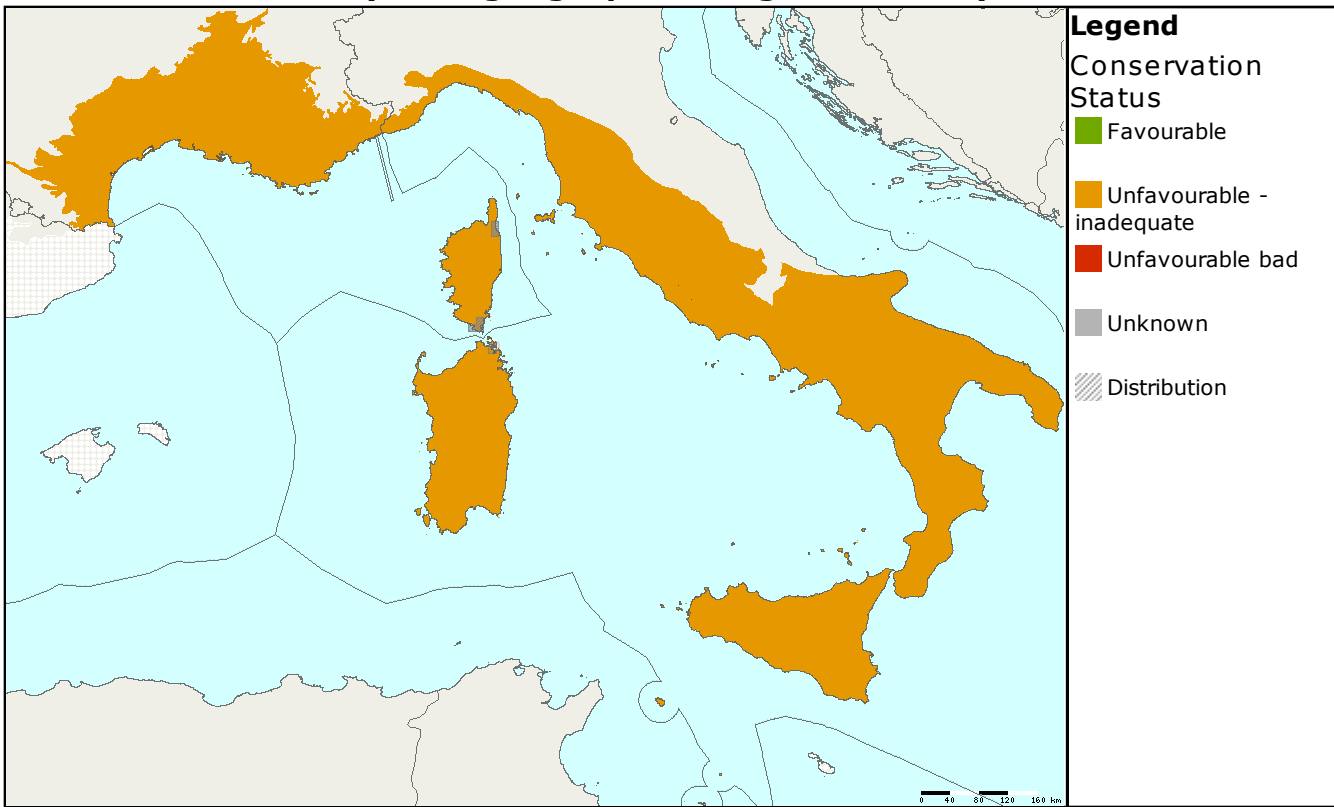

Limonium strictissimum is a plant endemic to the coast of Corsica (France) and Sardinia (Italy). It grows near the sea on a variety of substrates. Threats are habitat destruction, often linked to tourism. The overall assessment, as well as both national reports, is 'unfavourable-inadequate'. It is included in the IUCN list of the 50 most threatened plants of the Mediterranean islands and considered 'critically endangered'.
