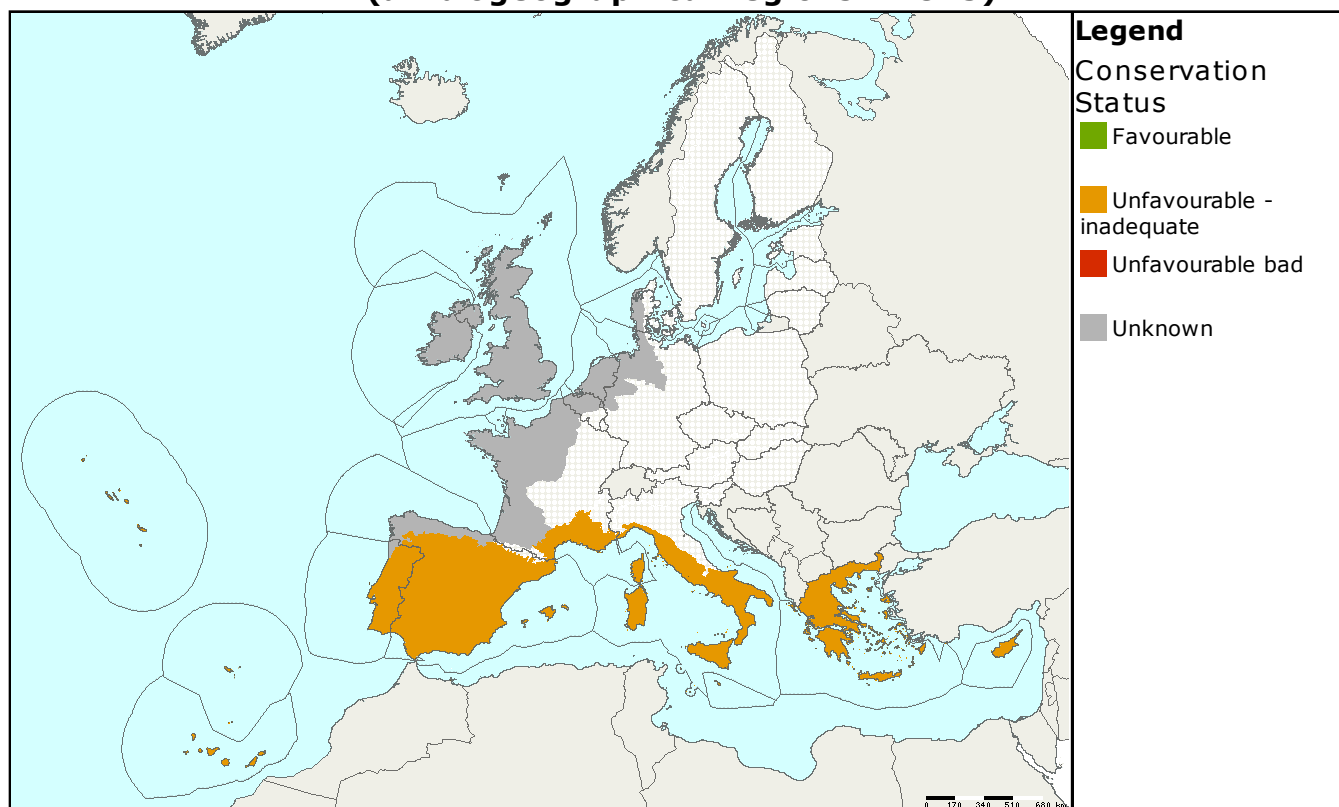

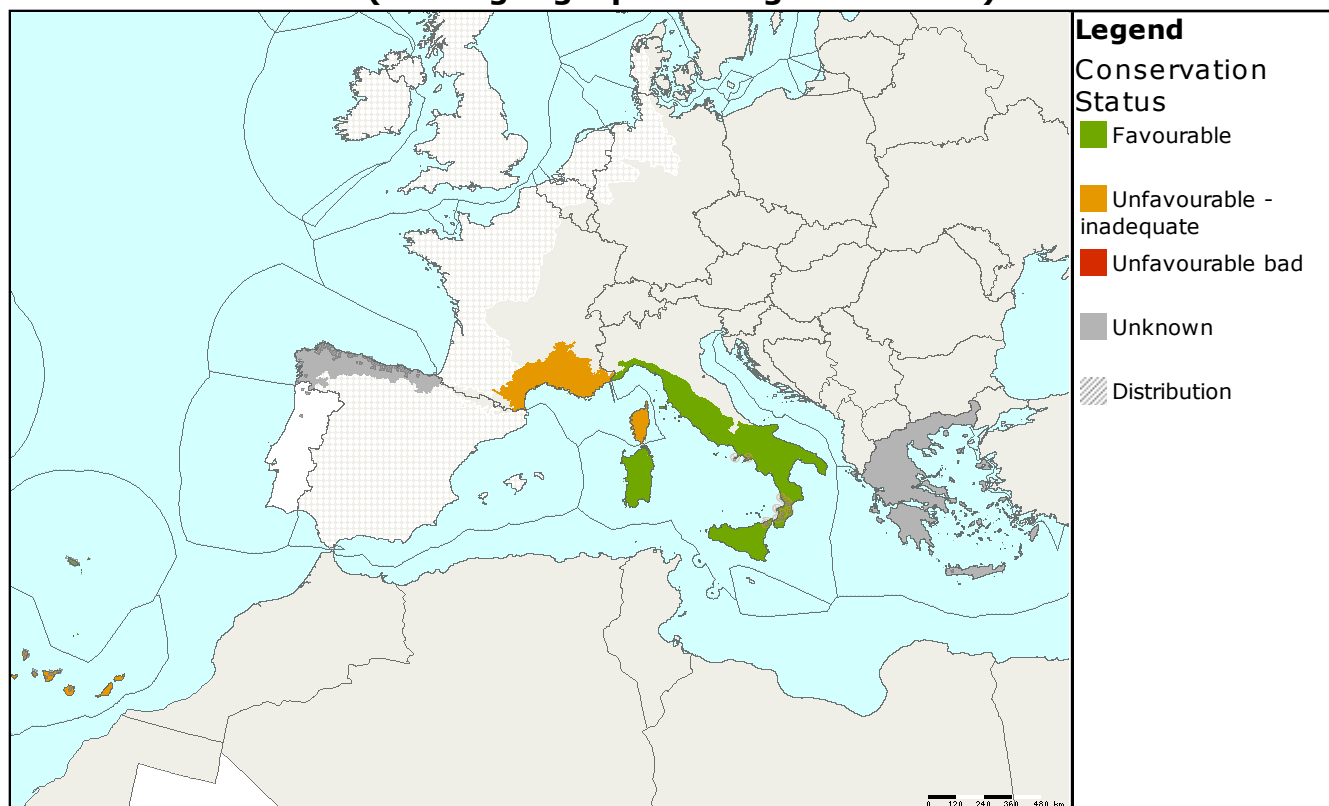

Woodwardia radicans is a fern known from the Iberian peninsula, Corsica (France), Italy, Crete and Macaronesia in Europe. It is also known from north and south America and Asia.

Assessed as 'unknown' for Atlantic region as very little information is provided by Spain or Portugal. In Macaronesian region it is assessed as 'unfavourable-inadequate' due to the population in Spain. However, this is close to the threshold for 'favourable'. The Spanish data is also not consistent with the reported assessments for some parameters. In Mediterranean region it is assessed as 'unfavourable-inadequate' due to population and future prospects in France but the reports from the other 3 countries are incomplete. Better information required for this species all around.
